Terms of Reference (updated September 2020)

Representation: Senior leadership (PVC R&E), membership from the Faculties, membership from Professional Services (including RaISE)

To maintain strategic oversight of the University's approach to Public Engagement with Research by

- monitoring the embedding of PER in i) the University Research Strategy ii) the Knowledge Exchange strategy, recognising that Research Impact is central to both; and that PER is a pathway to impact and of major significance to the profile of KEF
- monitoring the effectiveness, accessibility and inclusivity of our PER offer to the needs of our community partners and stakeholders
- monitoring and where appropriate seeking further to embed and enhance the coherence,

 leadership, reward and recognition, communication and listening, support and learning
